REQUIREMENTS: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY:

- participants must reside in the GTA and be 18 years of age or over
- open to **members and non-members** of Humber Valley Art Club
- paintings must be original work, not based on workshop demos or instructors' images, and not previously shown in the Neilson Park Creative Centre galleries

SUBMISSIONS ACCEPTED FROM SEPTEMBER 1 - OCTOBER 7, 2021:

- a donation of \$30 or more to World Wildlife Fund Canada is a condition of entry
- you will receive a tax receipt for your donation

- OR call World Wildlife Fund Canada and be sure to say you are donating to the "Humber Valley Art Club Fundraiser for Wildlife" ... call them at 1-800-267-2632

PAYMENT FOR ENTRY OF ARTWORKS: all payments are non-refundable

- \$20 for one painting, \$40 for two paintings, or three paintings for \$50
- by e-transfer or by cheque, between September 1 to September 30
- a) E-TRANSFER METHOD: send e-transfer to carolchrissy@sympatico.ca
- Use the message box in your e-transfer to include: your name, number of paintings and \$ amount Example: Jack Smith, 2 paintings, \$40
 - e-transfer Question is: what club is this? Answer is: HUMBER (all caps)

JPG ENTRY GUIDELINES FOR ONLINE SUBMISSIONS:

- all entries must be submitted online by email with a jpg image attached
- send email to carolchrissy@sympatico.ca with jpg attached

In the email be sure to include:

- 1. Your Name
- 2. Your address
- 3. Phone Number
- 4. Email address
- 5. Painting Title, Medium, Image Size (height x width) in inches, Framed Sized (h x w), Price
- 6. Attach the jpg image to your email

PHOTO IMAGES:

- Take a photo of your original work (not under glass), preferably in daylight. Use the highest resolution HD setting you have. Crop the image so that only the painting shows (no frame or mat).
- Include this essential information on your jpg image:

Artist's last name_Artist's first name_Title_Medium_HxW in inches_Price_jpg (framed size) e.g. Smith_Jack_GoldenPond_acrylic_20x26_\$400_jpg (no spaces)

How to Label Your JPEG or JPG:

SENDING YOUR JPG:

- Send your jpg's one at a time in an email to <u>carolchrissy@sympatico.ca</u> Make sure you include all relevant information in your email as listed in the entry guideline above.
- When your device asks you what size of photo you would like to select, choose "actual size" or the highest resolution available to send. This ensures the quality of your image is at its best.

OUR JUROR:

Margaret Roseman is an internationally known painter, working in both acrylic and watercolour. She is an award-winning artist, an international juror and a highly respected instructor/art educator. Margaret has instructed at national symposiums and painting workshops in many parts of the world, including Mexico, the Caribbean, France, Italy, the United States and Canada. Her work has been featured in international publications including: International Artist Magazine and Best of Worldwide Watermedia.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Paintings will not be juried into the show until all entries have been received and time has been allocated for the juried selection. You will be informed by email **if your painting(s) are accepted into the show (or not) by October 25th, 2021.**

SHOW PRIZES:

- 1st Prize \$300
- 2nd Prize \$200
- 3rd Prize \$125
- Honourable Mention \$100
- An additional prize of a one-year membership with Neilson Park Creative Centre worth \$110.

The paintings will be exhibited in the **Neilson Park Creative Centre Galleries** (Artspace Connect Gallery & Parkview Gallery) from November 8th to 28th OR in an online gallery, if that becomes necessary due to provincial health guidelines.

All accepted works must be delivered to, and picked up in person from Neilson Park Creative Centre, 56 Neilson Dr., Etobicoke. Drop-off & pick-up dates to be announced.

SELLING A PAINTING:

- Neilson Park Creative Centre charges a commission fee of 15% of the selling price for every artwork sold.
- HST on the selling price is also collected by NPCC
- NPCC processes sales at their front desk. Guests may pay by credit, debit, cheque or cash.
- If an artist has an HST number, they are asked to inform Neilson Park Creative Centre by email and they will be reimbursed for the HST charge.
- Artists are paid for sold artworks (less the 15% gallery commission fee) by cheque from NPCC within two weeks of the end of the exhibition. <u>Artworks may not be removed from the exhibition prior to the end-date of the show.</u>
