### **SUPPLIES AND MATERIALS:**

- Size 10 or 11 Czech seed beads (4-6 vials of assorted colours of your choice)
- A package of beading needles - No. 11 gold eye
- Nymo Nylon size 'D' beading thread (tex 35), a bobbin in white and a bobbin in black (size 'B' will also work if size 'D' is not available)
- 1/2 yard of Pellon - 926 Extra-Firm Stabilizer in the colour white
- A beading mat
- Tracing paper
- Small thread scissors or snips
- Ruler, regular scissors, pencils, eraser, coloured markers
