





In this 2 day workshop, participants will be introduced to basic weaving concepts and terminology, the components of a Rigid Heddle Loom and learn the direct warping method on a Rigid Heddle Loom. By the end of the class, students will have woven a 5' scarf (approximately) in a 2 colour design and learn basic finishing techniques. Materials and equipment are provided. The second section (Oct. 2, 16) will look at Fraktur, a specialty and favourite of Mark's. The last section (Oct. 16, 23) will look at Rotunda whose more rounded shapes demonstrate more clearly the Carolingian roots than its straight lined and angular blackletter siblings. Each of these two-week studies can be taken individually or get a discount for taking all three.


